World change starts with educating girls.

Background

Education For All (EFA) was founded in 2007 to respond to the high levels of illiteracy (estimated at 80%) amongst girls in the most deprived and remote areas of the High Atlas Mountains in Morocco. Instead of going to school, girls were staying home, doing domestic chores, marrying young and remaining in the cycle of poverty with limited choices in life.

THE 3 MAIN OBSTACLES FOR GIRLS IN RURAL MOROCCO

THEIR VILLAGES ARE TOO FAR AWAY FROM THE FEW SECONDARY SCHOOLS

THEIR FAMILIES ARE TOO POOR TO AFFORD THE GOVERNMENT LODGINGS AND TRAVEL COSTS

THERE IS LOW AWARENESS AND VALUE OF EDUCATING GIRLS

Solution

In 2007 a group of committed individuals living in Morocco (now the EFA Trustees) wanted to find a solution. They raised money to build the first boarding house near one of the main secondary schools in Asni. We now have **6 houses** running for over 200 girls. The EFA houses are a “home away from home”. Safe, comfortable and well-equipped each house provides:

The houses are staffed by local women which helps to create an environment where their culture is respected and trust is built within the local community.

We also run an international volunteer programme to support the girls in their studies, other languages and also to broaden their horizons.



Making the best investment

Not only is education a basic human right, but it also supports the development of all of society. And educated girl impacts her family, community and society at large. Literate mothers can make better decisions about their family's health and economies thrive when women are contributing their skills to employment.

Impact

The **short-term impact** of EFA's work is that many girls now have the opportunity to go to school who otherwise would be at home. They are thriving academically and becoming important role models in the region. **Your support will enable girls to reach their potential.** In 2019 we had a 100% pass for the BAC and sent 30 girls off to University, three with full scholarships. We now have over 130 girls enrolled at University since 2013, with two now studying their Master's Degree and more studying vocational diplomas- these women will become future lawyers, scientists, teachers and entrepreneurs! The **longer-term impact** is that these young women will be able to access professional jobs, become financially independent, contribute to the economy and have more choice and voice in Moroccan society.




